



Regional Fun Meet Hosting Grant

BC Artistic Swimming is invested in creating developmentally and age-appropriate opportunities for all members. The purpose of the Regional Fun Meet Hosting Grant is to support member clubs to provide a fun opportunity for developing athletes to participate in artistic swimming events, gain competition experience in a fun environment, and foster a love of artistic swimming without having to incur the potentially significant travel costs associated with provincial events.

Background

Regional Fun Meets provide additional opportunities for recreational athletes to participate in artistic swimming events. Since 2017 BCAS has supported Regional Fun Meets in each respective region: the Island, Interior and Lower Mainland. BC Artistic Swimming will continue to offer all recreational stream athletes in the province the opportunity to swim/perform at the Mabel Moran meet.

Regional Fun Meets are experiential opportunities for recreational athletes to:

- work towards a goal of performing figures and routines in front of a crowd that will include their peers and parents.
- provide a fun, safe and welcoming environment to introduce them to artistic swimming competitions ensuring that athletes experience an artistic swimming event with minimal travel costs and time commitments.
- get feedback from judges (or other sport leaders such as coaches and national stream athletes) to help them improve their skills and artistic swimming capacities.
- meet other swimmers and role models in their region and participate in fun games, activities, including provincial or national stream watershows.

BC Artistic Swimming Regional Fun Meet Hosting Grant Conditions

1. All Regional Fun Meet participants must be duly registered with BC Artistic Swimming for the current season.
2. Regional Fun Meet hosts must ensure that meet information (such as registration information and deadlines, schedules and meet programs) are distributed to all clubs in their region. BC Artistic Swimming can support the distribution of event information to clubs by email, through the website and on social media.
3. Regional Fun Meet hosts may opt to:
 - a. facilitate registration for the meet themselves (i.e., advertise, develop a registration process, collect meet fees from participating clubs, coordinate officials, etc.)

OR

- b. work with BC Artistic Swimming to manage the event through the CAS e-Registration System and with the support of BC Artistic Swimming staff.
4. Regional Fun Meet hosts choosing option 3 b), above, may be eligible to have the event expenses covered by BC Artistic Swimming. Event expenses may include, but are not limited to:
- a. Facility/pool rental fees
 - b. Participant awards or gifts
 - c. Officials travels expenses
 - d. a Regional Fun Meet Hosting Grant of up to 75% of the event net profits (revenue less expenses)

4.1 The value of the Regional Fun Meet Grant will be determined as follows:

Net Profit	Host Profits	Grant Value
\$1,000 or more	75%	\$750 +
\$750 - \$999	67%	\$502 - \$669
\$0 - \$500	50%	\$0 - \$250
