



2022-2023 Ignite Prospects Program

(December 7, 2022)

The Ignite Prospects Program is subject to change based on pool availability, program budget, consultant availability and other factors at the discretion of BC Artistic Swimming. An annual review of the plan will be undertaken by the BC Coaching Group and the updated plan will be released annually.

The vision of the BC Artistic Swimming Ignite Prospects Program is the early identification of prospective high-performance athletes in the late Learn to Train and early Train to Train stage of the Long-Term Athlete Development Framework. BCAS will rely on clubs to disseminate information regarding the program to their membership to share the information as broadly as possible. Figure results from the Provincial Stream Provincial Qualifier and Provincial Stream Provincial Championships will serve as talent identification resulting in a select group of athletes being invited to the Ignite Prospects Development Camp that aligns with the Ignite Assessment Camp (typically in June of each season). The goal of this program is to introduce athlete to the fun, collaborative, and positive high-performance artistic swimming environment.

Athlete Eligibility:

- Any age eligible athlete registered and in good standing for the current 2022-2023 season with a BC Artistic Swimming affiliated club and BC Artistic Swimming
- Age Eligibility: Athletes born in 2011, 2012 and 2013 and competing in **11-12 figures** at Mable Moran and/or Jean Peters Provincial Championships

Selection Events

The 2023 Provincial Stream Provincial Qualifiers (Mable Moran) and Provincial Stream Provincial Championships (Jean Peters) will be the selection events. The top 10 athletes at each event will receive a personal invitation to the 2023 Ignite Prospects Camp (June 2023 – exact date TBD).

Prospects Camp

Led by Ignite Program Coaches, participating athletes will have an opportunity to work on a variety of skills to enhance their artistic swimming abilities both on land and in water.

Cost

The cost to attend the Prospects Camp will be finalized once facilities have been arranged but is expected to be in the range of \$300-500 per athlete.
